Our Commercial or Business Purposes for Collecting Personal Data

- Offer support and assist with Service use.
- Personalize content and communications based on your preferences.
- Ensure fraud protection, security, and debugging.
- Fulfill legal obligations and enforce agreements.
- Protect rights, property, or safety.
- Resolve disputes and respond to inquiries.
- Carry out other business purposes as required by law, including compliance with data privacy regulations such as CCPA.

How We Share Your Personal Data

- We do not share your data (personal or otherwise) with third parties.

Business Transfers

All of your Personal Data that we collect may be transferred to a third party if we undergo a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy or other transaction in which that third party assumes control of our business (in whole or in part). Should one of these events occur, we will make reasonable efforts to notify you before your information becomes subject to different privacy and security policies and practices.

Cookies and Opt-Out

Our Services use cookies and similar technologies to recognize your web browser, track your usage, analyze trends, and improve our Services. Cookies are small data files, usually text, that are stored on your computer, tablet, phone, or other devices when you access our Services.

We use the following types of Cookies:

Essential Cookies: These are necessary for providing the features or services you’ve requested, such as logging into secure areas of our Services. Disabling them may make certain features unavailable.

Functional Cookies: These store your preferences and settings, helping us personalize content, greet you by name, and remember choices like filtering results and personal app settings..

Data Security and Retention

We take steps to protect your Personal Data from unauthorized access, use, and disclosure through physical, technical, organizational, and administrative security measures appropriate to the type of data and its processing. You should also safeguard your data by selecting strong passwords, limiting access to your devices, and logging out after using our Services. We strive to protect your information.

We retain Personal Data as long as your account is active or as needed to provide our Services. In some cases, we may retain data longer to comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, or collect fees. Data may also be kept in an anonymous or aggregated form that does not identify you personally.

Personal Data of Children

We do not knowingly collect or solicit Personal Data about children under 16 years of age; if you are a child under the age of 16, please do not attempt to register for or otherwise use the Services or send us any Personal Data. If we learn we have collected Personal Data from a child under 16 years of age, we will delete that information as quickly as possible. California Resident Rights

Access

You have the right to request information about our collection and use of your Personal Data over the past 12 months. Upon request, we will provide:

- The categories of Personal Data collected about you.
- The sources from which the data was collected.

- The business or commercial purposes for collecting or selling the data.
- The specific pieces of Personal Data collected.

Deletion

You have the right to request that we delete the Personal Data we have collected about you. Under the CCPA, this right is subject to certain exceptions. For example, we may need to retain your data to provide services or complete a transaction you've requested. If your deletion request falls under one of these exceptions, we may deny the request.

Exercising Your Rights

To exercise your rights, you or your Authorized Agent must submit a request that (1) provides sufficient information for us to verify your identity, and (2) describes your request in detail. Requests meeting these criteria will be considered "Valid Requests." We may not respond to requests that do not meet these criteria. Personal Data in a Valid Request will be used solely to verify your identity and fulfill the request.

We will respond to your Valid Request within 45 days. A fee may apply if your request is excessive, repetitive, or unfounded, and we will inform you if this is the case before proceeding.

To authorize an agent (an "Authorized Agent") to act on your behalf, provide them with written permission. We may request a copy of this permission when they submit a request.

European Union Data Subject Rights

If you are a resident of the European Union (EU), United Kingdom, Lichtenstein, Norway, or Iceland, you may have additional rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) regarding your Personal Data, as outlined below.

In this section, "Personal Data" and "processing" are defined according to the GDPR, where "Personal Data" refers to information that identifies an individual, and "processing" includes actions like collection, use, storage, and disclosure. TransferHub acts as the controller of your Personal Data processed in connection with our Services.

Other Processing Grounds: Occasionally, we may process data to comply with legal obligations or protect vital interest.

Objection: Object to further use or disclosure of your data for certain purposes, like direct marketing.

Restriction of Processing: Request limits on how we process your data.

Right to File Complaint: Lodge a complaint with your country's supervisory authority.

Transfers of Personal Data

Our Services are hosted and operated in the United States (U.S.), and in some cases, in the EU, through [TransferHub](#). If you reside outside the U.S., please note that U.S. laws may differ from those in your country.
